Grace Lane off Dalston Road

Dear Karle

As ward councillor I have been asked by Cummersdale parish council to bring to your attention the appalling state of Grace Lane. As you will be aware it was subject to a CPO by the Cumberland authority as part of the CSLR project.

It is classed as a bridleway connecting to Cummersdale and is a popular walk with locals as well as from the new estates on Dalston Road. It is also the access to three properties on Grace Lane and for the farmer to the fields at the top of the lane.

I understand that it will be adopted as part of the CSLR project and presumably will eventually be resurfaced and adopted.

I took the photographs below to illustrate just how bad it is. I measured one pothole at 5f X 4ft. It is so bad that I believe that it is a potential hazard to both horses and walkers. As a cyclist I have stopped using it as it is now too hazardous for cyclists. Some attempt was made to fill in the ones at the top of the lane but the rest is as you see here.

In the early stages of the CSLR the gate to the bridleway at the top of Gilbert Road was removed to facilitate access and was never replaced. It seems that someone in a 4X4 is using the lane as a quick access from Cummersdale to Dalston road.

The community would appreciate it if you would arrange for the potholes to be filled in and the gate replaced. Perhaps there are occasions when there is surplus tarmac from the CSLR project. In my opinion the holes are now far too large to simply fill in with sub-base
