(i) 20/0257 Erection Of Small Scale Standby Electricity Generation Plant In New Portal Framed Building; Installation Of Ancillary Equipment and Access Kingrigg Farm, Newby Cross, Carlisle, CA5 6JP, Previous application 16/0794

Resolved –Observations

Members are concerned that the site of the generation plant is in close proximity to the proposed southern link road and following its completion how will the site be accessed?

The application makes no reference to noise and emissions, and makes no data available to assess the impact members expressed concerns regarding pollution from the generation plant combined to emissions from the A595 and Southern link road and, that emissions and noise pollution will exceed that safely permitted.

(ii) Accounts & Audit, Deadline changes.

Noted the deadline by which the Annual Governance Statement and Statement of Accounts of the Annual Governance and Accountability Return (AGAR) together with any certificate or opinion issued by the local auditor must be published from 30 September 2020 to 30 November 2020. Previously there was a requirement for all smaller authorities to have a common period for the exercise of public rights, being the first 10 working days of July.

(iii) Noted the accounts will be submitted to the internal auditor week commencing 11th May2020.
